

## **Report of the Jurisprudence Committee**

I'm Thomas Rice, Iowa, chairman of the Jurisprudence Committee. I would like to introduce the other members of the committee: Charles Short, Indiana; Deb Moore, Wisconsin; and Linda Taylor, Ky.-Va.-W.Va.-Md.-D.C.

There were nineteen (19) proposed amendments to the UCT constitution by the UCT Board of Governors, Dianna Wolfe, president.

The changes are for continuity within the constitution or ritual except Amendment No. 18, which changes the word sessions to session.

After examination of the 2022 proposed amendments to the UCT constitution, we recommend that all nineteen (19) amendments be approved.

I, Deb Moore, Wisconsin, make a motion to approve all nineteen (19) amendments collectively. I, Charles Short, Indiana, second the motion.
